## **WORKING IN BAD WEATHER POLICY**

Commercial Diving and Marine operations are carried out in the most adverse environments and conditions.

Taking into account the possibility of bad weather is therefore an absolute necessity for setting the limits of acceptable working conditions.

We undertake to :

- Identify and assess the meteorological hazards associated to all operations before they begin.
- Establish in our operational procedures the limits of weather conditions beyond which specific activities or the whole operation must be stopped.
- Make sure all personnel are aware of the procedures applicable to their position.
- Draw up for each team a Manual of Permitted Operations which defines the conditions for carrying out specific activities in deteriorating circumstances.
- Make sure all operations in deteriorating circumstances are carried out only with the approval and under the supervision of the Project Manager, in accordance with the Manual of Permitted Operations.
